

SAFETY CHECKLIST waste & recycling

SHORT-TERM ACTIONABLE ITEMS

Checks, Inspections & Reviews

Conduct a visual check to ensure all employees are wearing high-visibility clothing, gloves, safety eyewear, and hard hats before starting their shift.

Conduct a visual inspection of all machinery and equipment to check for any signs of damage, leaks, or abnormalities.

Conduct a review of material handling tasks to identify any areas where employees may be at risk of injury.

Inspect all machinery to ensure that guards and barriers are in place and properly secured.

Conduct a visual inspection of all waste collection and transport vehicles to ensure that safety features are functioning correctly.

Conduct an audit of hazardous waste storage areas to ensure that containers are properly labeled, sealed, and stored according to regulations.

Review procedures for handling and disposing of hazardous waste with all relevant staff members to reinforce compliance and awareness.

Inspect all emergency response equipment, including first-aid kits, eyewash stations, and fire extinguishers, to ensure they are fully stocked and in working condition.

Conduct a walkthrough of the facility to ensure that safety signs, labels, and posters are visible, legible, and properly maintained.

Replace any damaged or missing safety signage and address any areas where additional signage may be needed to improve safety awareness.

Training & Scheduling

Review employee records to verify completion of required safety training and certification requirements.

Schedule makeup training sessions for employees who have not completed mandatory safety training or certification renewal.

Systems & Processes

Establish a regular inspection schedule for PPE to ensure it remains in good condition and replace any damaged or worn-out equipment promptly.

Implement a system for tracking PPE usage and ensuring that all employees have access to properly fitting gear.

Establish a comprehensive maintenance schedule for all machinery, including routine inspections, lubrication, and servicing.

Implement a system for regular maintenance and inspection of machine guarding systems, including documentation of inspections and any necessary repairs or adjustments.

Establish a comprehensive vehicle maintenance program, including regular inspections, servicing, and record-keeping to ensure compliance with safety regulations.

Implement a preventive maintenance program for all fleet vehicles, including scheduled inspections, oil changes, and component replacements as recommended by manufacturers.

Establish protocols for routine inspections and audits of hazardous waste storage areas to maintain compliance and identify any areas for improvement.
