

TOP 5 SAFETY RISKS:

CONSTRUCTION



01

Falls from Height

Working on scaffolds, ladders, or roofs exposes workers to severe fall hazards, often resulting from inadequate fall protection or unstable working surfaces.

02

Struck-By Incidents

Heavy equipment, falling tools, and moving vehicles on-site create constant risks of being struck, especially in congested or poorly managed work zones.

03

Caught-In or Between Hazards

Trench collapses, equipment rollovers, and material handling accidents can trap workers, making this one of the most fatal risks in construction.

04

Electrical Hazards

Exposed wiring, overhead power lines, and improper lockout/tagout practices place workers at risk of shocks, burns, and fatal electrocution.

05

Musculoskeletal Injuries

Repetitive motion, heavy lifting, and awkward postures contribute to strains and sprains that may not be immediately life-threatening but lead to long-term health issues and lost productivity.
