Machine-Related Injuries

Moving parts, pinch points, and lack of proper guarding on machinery can cause severe cuts, amputations, or crushing injuries in seconds.

Exposure to Hazardous Substances

Workers are often exposed to chemicals, dust, and fumes that, without proper ventilation and PPE, can lead to burns, respiratory issues, or long-term illness.

Slips, Trips, and Falls

Wet floors, cluttered walkways, and uneven surfaces contribute to frequent injuries that disrupt operations and cause costly downtime.

04

Ergonomic Strains

Repetitive motions, overexertion, and poor workstation design can lead to musculoskeletal disorders that reduce productivity and cause chronic pain.

05

Electrical and Fire Hazards

Faulty wiring, overloaded circuits, and flammable materials create significant risks of electrical shock or fire, especially in high-output production environments.
