

# TOP 5 SAFETY RISKS:

## UTILITY



01

### Electrical Shock and Arc Flash

Workers face constant exposure to high-voltage lines and energized equipment, where a single mistake can cause severe burns, shock, or fatal electrocution.

### Falls from Height

Climbing poles, towers, and elevated structures puts workers at serious risk, especially without proper fall protection and secure working platforms.

03

### Vehicle and Equipment Incidents

Utility crews frequently work near moving traffic and operate heavy machinery, creating risks of collisions, run-overs, and equipment-related injuries.

04

### Hazardous Atmospheres

Confined spaces, manholes, and underground vaults may contain toxic gases or oxygen-deficient environments, requiring continuous monitoring and proper PPE.

05

### Weather and Environmental Hazards

Outdoor work exposes crews to lightning, extreme temperatures, ice, and flooding, all of which can quickly escalate routine tasks into dangerous situations.
